

Easter Sunday

- The Oils will be presented
 - This is done at the beginning of the Mass. The people presenting the oils should be in the procession right after the cross. If there is incense the presenters should stand off to the side of the altar until after the altar is blessed. They can then move to the front of the altar. If the choir is given prior notice they may sign the presentation of the oils. Otherwise the priest may read the presentation. As each oil is named the person holding that oil should move forward and elevate the oil or in some way make the oil more noticeable.
 - They are presented in the following order
 - Oil of the Sick ("Oleum Infirmorum") (OI)
 - Oil of Catechumens ("Oleum Sanctum") (OS)
 - Holy Chrism ("Sanctum Chrisma") (SC)
- Incense may be used.
- Set out and light the Easter Candle upon arrival.
- While there is no Holy Thursday service at Corpus Christi, the reception of the Oils will take place on Easter Sunday. There should be a paper with the text inserted into the Sacramentary.
- Place sprinkler and bowl with holy water for sprinkling on the credence table.
- If the water needs to be blessed the blessing of Holy Water is found in the Sacramentary, on the page 412. Just before the first tab.
- There will be a profession of Faith (question answer type creed) rather than the Creed. This is done right after the Homily. The profession is found on the same page as the opening prayers.
- First adult server will have to hold the book during the profession. When the 1st Adult server gets up with the book the 2nd Adult server should get the sprinkler and bowl and be ready to follow Father during the blessing of the Congregation.
- There may be a 3 fold blessing at the end of the mass? If so it would be found on page 628
